



Candy Lighthouses

I felt like the ones made with the rolled mints needed a base, so I used scallop punch cut-outs with a wrapped mint patty sandwiched between.

Lighthouse Favors from Breath Mints (with Hole in Center)

Supplies for Candy Lighthouses

Supplies (Smaller Size Lighthouse):

- Stripe scrapbook paper. I got mine from Hobby Lobby (sold individually by sheets).
- Cardstock for punch cut-outs. I used shades of blue, but color choice is up to you.
- Rolled Candy/Mints – 1 roll for each lighthouse. (I used Breath Savers because you can buy them in a value size package.)



- Round Packaged Mint Patties – 1 patty for each lighthouse. (I got mine from Walmart. They were Pearson's Brand.)
- Rolo Candy – 1 candy for each lighthouse.
- Transparent Tape.
- Low Temperature Glue Gun.
- Paper Cutter
- Small Candy Lighthouse

Directions (Smaller Size Lighthouse):

- Use the Scallop Punch to make 2 cut-outs for each lighthouse. (You could use a round punch instead. The scallops are approximately 1 and 3/4 inches.)
- Use a low temp glue gun to adhere a mint patty between 2 scallops. Hold for about 30 seconds.
- Measure your mint/candy roll (length and width) leaving a little extra on the width to overlap.
- Cut your scrapbook paper to the size of your rolls.
- Use transparent tape along the seam to attach. The seam will be your back.
- Use a low temp glue gun to adhere the paper-wrapped rolled mints to the top scallop of the mint patty piece you have already made. Glue on bottom of roll, then stand it up in the middle of the scallop and hold for about 30 seconds.
- Use a low temp glue gun to adhere a Rolo candy to the top of the candy roll. Glue on the wider side of candy and hold for about 30 seconds.

Lighthouse Favors from M & M Holders

Supplies: (Larger Size Lighthouse):

- Stripe scrapbook paper. I got mine from Hobby Lobby (sold individually by sheets).
- M & M Mini Candy Containers – 1 for each lighthouse.
- Rolo Candy – 2 for each lighthouse.
- Transparent Tape.
- Low Temperature Glue Gun.
- Paper Cutter.



Directions (Larger Size Lighthouse):

- Cut your scrapbook paper to 4 3/4 height and 4 1/4 width.
- Use transparent tape along the seam to attach. The seam will be your back.
- Use a low temp glue gun to adhere 2 Rolo candies back to back on wider side of candy to form the "light". (See photo above.) Hold for about 30 seconds.
- Use a low temp glue gun to adhere the two glued Rolo candies to the top of the M&M container.
- Hold for about 30 seconds.
