



Book of Daniel (12 chapters)

- Main Characters: God, Daniel, three kings, bad guys, and lions
- Highlights: Daniel interpreting dreams and writing, Daniel and his prayer life, and Daniel thrown into the lion's den.

Book of 1 Samuel (31 chapters)

- Main Characters: God, Hannah, Eli the Priest and wicked sons, Saul, David, Goliath, and Jonathan
- Highlights: Hannah's story of infertility to blessing, the wickedness of Eli's evil sons, Saul becoming king, David slaying Goliath, the friendship of Jonathan and David, and Saul's pursuit to kill David.

Book of Ruth (4 chapters)

- Main Characters: God, Ruth, Naomi, and Boaz
- Highlights: Ruth's relationship with her mother-in-law, Naomi, their journey to Bethlehem, the love story of Ruth and Boaz, and Naomi having a grandson.

Book of Esther (10 chapters)

- Main Characters: God, Esther, King Ahasuerus, Queen Vashti, Mordecai, and Haman
- Highlights: Queen Vashti's disobedience to the king, Esther becoming queen, Haman and his antics, Mordecai's wisdom, and Esther striving to save her people.

Book of Jonah (4 chapters)

- Main Characters: God, Jonah, some sailors, and a big fish
- Highlights: Jonah running from God, Jonah's time in a fish, and the repentance of the city Nineveh.

Genesis 37-50 (13 chapters)

- Main Characters: God, Joseph, Joseph's family, Potiphar, and Pharaoh
- Highlights: Joseph and his dreams, the jealousy of his brothers, Joseph being sold into slavery, Joseph going to jail, and Joseph rising to power.
